Safe environment training

The Archdiocese of Seattle requires all staff members, parents, grandparents, and volunteers, to participate in Safe Environment Training every 3 years. Initial training is a 3-hour class held at Our Lady of Lourdes or another Catholic parish in Vancouver.

Register for a training **and** submit a background check at virtusonline.org and select Seattle, WA (Archdiocese) as the location.
